This letter is to inform you that Asetine School will be changing our hybrid schedule by increasing days on campus effective 3/22/21. In-person learning will be offered Monday through Wednesday from 8:30 A.M-1:00 P.M and distance learning will be offered Thursday and Friday. This schedule will remain in place until further notice. As soon as any changes are finalized, we will contact you again. For those of you who use district transportation services, please note that the transportation department for each of our contracting school districts will contact you directly if times of pick-up and drop-off will be changed due to increasing our days for in-person instruction.

Please note that in this 2nd phase of our reopening plan, we are also allowing physical access to district related service providers and other district personnel for the purposes of assessments and observations. This change will be effective 4/12/21. Please note that due to the size of our campus the number of people will be limited. All individuals will be screened and required to follow our policies and procedures as outlined in our COVID-19 Prevention Plan.
